Universal Training	
<b>Combined FAA/JAA Program</b> Provides complete European certification by combining JAA/EASA CPL(H) training with elements from the FAA Professional Pilot Program. <b>Duration: 12-14 months</b>	
<b>FAA Professional Pilot</b> Includes Private Pilot, Instrument Rating, Commercial Pilot, Certified Flight Instructor (CFI), CFI-Instrument (CFII) and External Load. <b>Duration: 9-11 months</b>	
<b>Military Training</b> Prepares pilots for military missions with focused flight training and specialized skills, including Primary, Transition, Instrument, NVG and Mission Planning. <b>Duration: 7 months</b>	
<b>Combined Civilian/Military Training</b> FAA or JAA/EASA qualifications attained in conjunction with Military Training elements.

<b>FAA Private Pilot</b> Prepares student to pilot a helicopter under a variety of conditions. <b>Duration: 12 weeks</b>	<b>JAA/EASA PPL(H)</b> Prepares student to pilot a helicopter as a private pilot under a variety of conditions. <b>Duration: 8-10 weeks</b>
<b>FAA Instrument Rating</b> Certifies student to fly in restricted visibility situations. <b>Duration: 8 weeks</b>	<b>JAA/EASA FI(H)</b> Prepares JAA CPL(H) certified pilots to instruct pilots in JAA/EASA member countries. <b>Duration: 6 weeks (3 weeks for ICAO CFI(H) holders)</b>
<b>FAA Commercial Pilot</b> Certifies student to work as a professional helicopter pilot. (Private Pilot Certificate or higher required) <b>Duration: 3 months</b>	<b>JAA/EASA CPL(H)</b> Provides training needed for the JAA/EASA Commercial Pilot license. <b>Duration: 48 weeks</b>
<b>External Load</b> Instructs certified pilot in the methods and techniques of carrying a load outside the helicopter, including safe long-line operations. <b>Duration: 3 weeks</b>	<b>JAA/EASA IR(H)</b> Certifies student to fly in instrument meteorological conditions. <b>Duration: 8 weeks (4 weeks for ICAO IR(H) holders)</b>
<b>FAA Certified Flight Instructor (CFI)</b> Prepares certified FAA Commercial Pilots for CFI examinations. <b>Duration: 8 weeks</b>	<b>JAA/EASA Type Rating</b> Trains JAA/EASA PPL or CPL holders to pilot specific helicopter types (including Sikorsky 300 CBi, Robinson R22, Robinson R44, Bell 206 JetRanger and Eurocopter AS355). <b>Duration: 1 week per rating type</b>
